69% of all the requests for child care to the child care resource and referral programs were for infant and toddler care





In Center-Based Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:4 for 6 weeks through 23 months; 1:5 for 24 through 35 months
*Ratio may be 1:10 if all children are 36 months to attending K
(State Licensing Regulations)

In Registered Family Child Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:2 for 6 weeks to 24 months; 1:6 under school age, 1:10 if at least 4 are school age and no more than 2 are under 24 months

In Certified Family Care the staff to child ratios are

In same age group: 1:4, 6 weeks to 24 months, 1:10 24 months to school age; 1-12th grade and above

In blended age groups where there are children under 24 months: 1:8 (with no more than 1 under 24 months); 1:7 (with no more than 2 under 24 months); 1:6 (with no more than 3 under 24 months); 1:4 (if all are under 24 months)

Average annual fee for full-time child care for an infant in center based care..... \$7,560

Cost of child care for an infant as percent of median income for two-parent families 12%

Cost of child care for an infant as percent of median income for single parent families..... 39%
